# Summary

- ❖ 92 calls for service in the Village of Denmark from 6/1/2024 6/30/2024
- ❖ Brown County Sheriff's Office (BCSO) deputies provide additional enforcement, police services and respond to calls for service when DEOs are not available.

## In the Community

- PRESCRIPTION DRUG TAKE BACK As a reminder, this drop off site is also open Monday Friday during normal Village of Denmark municipal hours.
- Coffee with a Cop Denmark Officers will be at DeGrand Family Restaurant for Coffee with a Cop generally the first Tuesday of the month from 8-9 AM. The next event will be Tuesday, August 13, 2024. Residents can come in to ask questions, voice their concerns, and get to know the Village Officers!
- ❖ Frogger BCSO east side DEO's completed the first Frogger Crosswalk Safety Event for the year on June 27. 10 traffic stops were made for failure to yield right of way in the crosswalk in the Village of Denmark, and 0 citations were issued.
- Citizen Request for 4 Way Stop Sign There have been two separate requests from Village of Denmark residents to make the intersection of Woodrow St and Oak St a 4-way stop to control speeding issues on Woodrow St particularly at Salm Partners shift changes. The speed board has been placed at this location, and the statistics will be reviewed before making a recommendation.

### **Meetings, Associations & Presentations.**

❖ Denmark Municipal Court is scheduled for **August 7**, **2024**, at **6:30PM**. Denmark Municipal Court is normally scheduled for the first Wednesday of the month at 6:30 PM (subject to change).

#### **Traffic / Ordinance Enforcement**

- Officers use traffic enforcement as one mean to modify, correct and educate operators on dangerous driving behavior. Traffic citations are issued to gain compliance with the law.
  - There were 27 traffic <u>contacts</u> initiated and 4 traffic <u>crashes</u> in the Village of Denmark.
    - Of those traffic contacts, 11 traffic <u>citations</u> were issued, and 32 traffic <u>warnings</u> were issued.
    - 0 OWI arrests / citations.
- Ordinance citations are used to enforce the codes that are specific to Denmark. There were 5 ordinance citation(s) issued.

#### **Administrative**

- Denmark DEO's actively assisting BCSO Investigative with 1 case.
- Significant Calls for Service:
  - Suspicious Person DEO Rusk was approached by an individual on the Devil's River Trail who advised there was a male subject hiding in the bushes and possibly living in the woods just off the trail. The area was extensively checked, and the male was not located. This situation is continuing to be monitored.
  - Accident BCSO Deputies responded to a two-vehicle crash in front of Family Dollar on DePere Rd.
     There were no injuries, and one citation was issued.
  - Sexual Assault BCSO Deputies responded to the Village for a report of a sexual assault. This incident resulted in an arrest and criminal charges.
  - Suspicious Person BCSO Deputies responded to an apartment complex in the Village for an unknown male talking to himself in the hallway of the complex. The male was arrested for an outstanding warrant. No new criminal charges resulted from this incident.
  - Suspicious Situation DEO Rusk is currently assisting BCSO Investigators to investigate a suspicious situation that occurred at a residence in the Village.
  - Drugs Call DEO Rusk responded to Family Dollar for a baggie of crystal meth found on the floor in the store that was dropped by a customer. The drugs were taken to the BCSO and entered for destruction.
     The owner is unknown.
  - Accident DEO Pigeon helped investigate a report of a possibly intoxicated driver that hit two mailboxes.

    Contact was attempted with the suspect the night of the incident, but officers were unable to make contact with the suspect. More follow up is being conducted.
  - Disturbance DEO Pigeon investigated a physical disturbance that occurred at Rookie's Bar. Two subjects admitted to fighting at the bar.

#### Chronic Nuisance Properties (CNP)

- Currently, there is 1 property deemed a CNP in the Village of Denmark.
- o DEO's working with Landlord(s)/tenants.

#### Sex Offender Registrants

- o Currently there are no active Sex Offender Residency Appeals.
- Currently O Sex Offender (pending) Appeal process for Residency within the Village.

#### ❖ Patrol Vehicles/Equipment

- The speed board has been moved to Woodrow St and Oak St due to speeding complaints in the area.
- The gray Durango has been having mechanical issues causing it to stall out and not start. The fuel pump has been replaced, and an exposed wire has been repaired but the issue has not been resolved. The BCSO mechanic is looking into the issue further.

#### Crime Stoppers

- Both DEOs continue to monitor anonymous tips that come in through Green Bay Area Crime Stoppers. These tips are received at Crime Stoppers through phone or online. DEOs are then forwarded these tips for follow-up.


#### **❖** House Check Requests


