- Brown County Sheriff's Office (BCSO) deputies provide additional enforcement, police services and respond to calls for service when DEOs are not available.

- ❖ PRESCRIPTION DRUG TAKE BACK As a reminder, this drop off site is also open Monday Friday during normal Village of Denmark municipal hours.
- ❖ Coffee with a Cop Denmark Officers will be at DeGrand Family Restaurant for Coffee with a Cop the first Tuesday of the month from 8-9 AM. The next event will be Tuesday July 2, 2024. Residents can come in to ask questions, voice their concerns, and get to know the Village Officers!
- Frogger The next Frogger Crosswalk Safety event is scheduled for Thursday, June 27.

Meetings, Associations & Presentations.

❖ Denmark Municipal Court is scheduled for July 10, 2024, at 6:30PM. Denmark Municipal Court is normally scheduled for the first Wednesday of the month at 6:30 PM (subject to change). Court for July will be held on July 10 due to the Holiday.

Traffic / Ordinance Enforcement

- Officers use traffic enforcement as one mean to modify, correct and educate operators on dangerous driving behavior. Traffic citations are issued to gain compliance with the law.
 - There were 11 traffic <u>contacts</u> initiated and 3 traffic <u>crashes</u> in the Village of Denmark.
 - Of those traffic contacts, 7 traffic <u>citations</u> were issued, and 16 traffic <u>warnings</u> were issued.
 - 0 OWI arrests / citations.
- Ordinance citations are used to enforce the codes that are specific to Denmark. There were 6 ordinance citation(s) issued.

Administrative

- ❖ Denmark DEO's actively assisting BCSO Investigative with 1 case.
- Significant Calls for Service:
 - Suspicious Person BCSO Deputies responded to a residence in the Village for an unknown/unexpected subject knocking on a resident's door late at night. The resident did not answer the door and the suspect was not located.
 - Accident DEO Rusk responded to a minor two vehicle accident at the intersection of Highridge Ave and N Wall St involving two vehicles enroute to the schools. There were no injured parties and both vehicles sustained minor damage.
 - Disturbance BCSO Deputies responded to an apartment complex in the Village for a verbal disturbance between multiple people over possible illegal dumping of garbage in a dumpster. All parties were separated and sent on their way.
 - Theft DEO Pigeon handled a theft by an employee at a business in the Village. Criminal charges have been referred.
 - Noise Complaints DEO Pigeon responded to a residence in the Village for a noise complaint. This
 incident resulted in a citation for Disorderly Conduct being issued.
 - Disturbances There were three different disturbances in the Village that resulted in domestic violence related arrests and charges.
 - Burglary DEO Pigeon handled a complaint of a burglary that occurred at a residence in the Village. Two
 firearms were taken from the victim's home.

- Currently, there is 1 property deemed a CNP in the Village of Denmark.

- Currently there are no active Sex Offender Residency Appeals.




