- ❖ 97 calls for service in the Village of Denmark from 8/1/2024 8/31/2024
- ❖ Brown County Sheriff's Office (BCSO) deputies provide additional enforcement, police services and respond to calls for service when DEOs are not available.

In the Community

- ❖ PRESCRIPTION DRUG TAKE BACK As a reminder, this drop off site is also open Monday Friday during normal Village of Denmark municipal hours.
- ❖ Coffee with a Cop Denmark Officers will be at DeGrand Family Restaurant for Coffee with a Cop generally the first Tuesday of the month from 8-9 AM. The next event will be Tuesday, October 1, 2024. Residents can come in to ask questions, voice their concerns, and get to know the Village Officers!
- Public Safety Meeting DEO's had a meeting with the Public Safety committee to speak about golf carts, electric scooter/bicycle safety, and a citizen request for a stop sign on Woodrow St and Oak St.
- Cops & Bobbers DEO Rusk participated in the Boys and Girls Club event "Cops and Bobbers" and fished with youth from throughout Brown County.
- Cops at Culvers DEO Pigeon assisted with the Cops and Culver's Event hosted by the Police Lights of Christmas. This event raises money to provide all Brown County Deputies with gift cards to hand out to individuals in need throughout the year.
- ❖ Frogger Denmark DEO's participated in the second Frogger event of 2024.

Meetings, Associations & Presentations.

❖ Denmark Municipal Court is scheduled for **October 2, 2024**, at **6:30PM**. Denmark Municipal Court is normally scheduled for the first Wednesday of the month at 6:30 PM (subject to change).

Traffic / Ordinance Enforcement

- Officers use traffic enforcement as one mean to modify, correct and educate operators on dangerous driving behavior. Traffic citations are issued to gain compliance with the law.
 - There were 24 traffic contacts initiated and 4 traffic crashes in the Village of Denmark.
 - Of those traffic contacts, **7** traffic <u>citations</u> were issued, and **22** traffic <u>warnings</u> were issued.
 - 0 OWI arrests / citations.

• Ordinance citations are used to enforce the codes that are specific to Denmark. There were 2 ordinance citation(s) issued.

Administrative

- Denmark DEO's actively assisting BCSO Investigative with 1 case.
- Significant Calls for Service:
 - Welfare Call BCSO Deputies responded to the Village for a welfare check report. This call resulted in criminal charges of Obstruction and Filing a False Police Report.
 - Disturbance DEO Pigeon responded to a disturbance at McDonald's in the Village. Reports indicated a
 female at the business was refusing to leave. This incident ended peacefully with no issues.
 - Burglary DEO Rusk handled a burglary complaint at an apartment complex in the Village. Many valuable items were taken from the victim's apartment. This incident is still being investigated.
 - Disturbance BCSO Deputies responded to the Village for a disturbance. This call resulted in no criminal charges and parties were separated.
 - Theft DEO Pigeon handled a complaint of a theft. Numerous items were taken from an apartment in the village. The victim and subject were known to each other. This call resulted in criminal charges being referred on both involved parties.

Chronic Nuisance Properties (CNP)

- Currently, there is 1 property deemed a CNP in the Village of Denmark. There is a second residence being
 investigated as another chronic nuisance.
- DEO's working with Landlord(s)/tenants.

❖ Sex Offender Registrants

- Currently there are no active Sex Offender Residency Appeals.
- Currently O Sex Offender (pending) Appeal process for Residency within the Village.

❖ Patrol Vehicles/Equipment

- o The speed board has been placed on Woodrow St and Oak St due to speeding complaints in the area.
- The white Durango squad lights have been working well since the most recent fix.
- o The gray Durango has also been running well since the latest fix.

- Both DEOs continue to monitor anonymous tips that come in through Green Bay Area Crime Stoppers.
 These tips are received at Crime Stoppers through phone or online. DEOs are then forwarded these tips for follow-up.

Park hours

Reminder, Memorial Park hours for the public are from 8:00 a.m. – 10:00 p.m. No person shall be present
in the park after hours. Parking ordinances are also enforced within the park after hours.

Off-the-road vehicles

 Reminder, Village code 208-18 states "No person shall ride or operate, or permit a child to operate, any bicycle, minibike, trail bike, all-terrain vehicle or other vehicle except in areas specially designated for its use" – Other vehicles include golf carts.

House Check Requests

Remember, if you're leaving town for a weekend or taking a vacation or traveling –fill out a house check request form; it can be located on the village website. These forms are forwarded to DEOs for documentation, checks, and extra patrol. These checks offer extra supervision over your home and provide DEOs information on who to contact while you are away if needed as well as what to expect for activity/vehicles at your home.




