Summary

- ❖ **145** calls for service in the Village of Denmark from **9/1/2024 – 9/30/2024**
- ❖ Brown County Sheriff's Office (BCSO) deputies provide additional enforcement, police services and respond to calls for service when DEOs are not available.

In the Community

- ❖ **PRESCRIPTION DRUG TAKE BACK** – As a reminder, this drop off site is also open Monday – Friday during normal Village of Denmark municipal hours.
- ❖ **Coffee with a Cop** – Denmark Officers will be at DeGrand Family Restaurant for Coffee with a Cop generally the first Tuesday of the month from 8-9 AM. The next event will be **Tuesday, November 5, 2024**. Residents can come in to ask questions, voice their concerns, and get to know the Village Officers!
- ❖ **Woodrow St Speed Board Data** – I have included Speed Board Data from 9/1/2024 – 10/1/2024 to review in reference to citizen request for a 4-way stop sign on Woodrow St/Oak St
- ❖ **Frogger** – Denmark DEO's participated in the final Frogger event of 2024 on 10/2/2024.

Meetings, Associations & Presentations.

- ❖ Denmark Municipal Court is scheduled for **November 6, 2024**, at **6:30PM**. Denmark Municipal Court is normally scheduled for the first Wednesday of the month at 6:30 PM (subject to change).

Traffic / Ordinance Enforcement

- ❖ Officers use **traffic enforcement** as one mean to modify, correct and educate operators on dangerous driving behavior. Traffic citations are issued to gain compliance with the law.
 - There were **24** traffic contacts initiated and **7** traffic crashes in the Village of Denmark.
 - Of those traffic contacts, **14** traffic citations were issued, and **22** traffic warnings were issued.
 - **0** OWI arrests / citations.
- ❖ **Ordinance citations** are used to enforce the codes that are specific to Denmark. There were **0** ordinance citation(s) issued.

Administrative

- ❖ Denmark DEO's actively assist BCSO Investigative with investigations in the Village.
- ❖ **Significant Calls for Service:**

- **Accident** – BCSO Deputies responded to I-43 / North Ave for a one vehicle crash. The vehicle drove off the highway and into the ditch
- **Homeless Male** – Village DEO's and BCSO responded to numerous complaints regarding a homeless individual pushing a shopping cart in the Village. The Individual did not cause any issues, and help was provided by community members. The individual is no longer in the area.
- **Burglary in Progress** – BCSO deputies responded to a burglary in progress in the Village. When the complainant got home it appeared that their apartment had been entered by an unknown person. This call generated a large police response. Deputies did not locate any signs of forced entry, and nothing was found to be missing.
- **Theft of Mail** – DEO Pigeon handled a complaint regarding theft of a mail package. During the investigation into this incident and shortly after inquiring with neighbors about the missing package it was returned unharmed.
- **Attempted Burglaries** – DEO Pigeon and BCSO Deputies responded to the Green Bay Rd area for reports of an unknown subject attempting to enter vehicles and garages. Nothing was reported missing from any of the witnesses or possible victims.
- **Trespass Calls** – With school back in session Deputies and DEO's have responded to several complaints of trespassers at 305 S Wall St (Land O Lakes). DEO Rusk has been in contact with the property manager about cleaning the property up and possible measures to prevent trespassing at this location.
- **Disturbance** – BCSO Deputies responded to the Village for a domestic disturbance. This incident resulted in an arrest with domestic violence related charges.
- **Hit and Run Crash** – DEO Rusk is investigating a Hit and Run Crash that occurred in the Bank First ATM drive through. A vehicle struck the brick wall.

❖ **Chronic Nuisance Properties (CNP)**

- Currently, there are 0 properties deemed a CNP in the Village of Denmark. There is a second residence being investigated as another chronic nuisance.
- DEO's working with Landlord(s)/tenants.

❖ **Sex Offender Registrants**

- Currently there are no active Sex Offender Residency Appeals.
- Currently 0 Sex Offender (pending) Appeal process for Residency within the Village.

❖ **Patrol Vehicles/Equipment**

- The speed board has been placed on Woodrow St and Oak St due to speeding complaints in the area.

Joint Efforts

❖ **Crime Stoppers**

- Both DEOs continue to monitor anonymous tips that come in through Green Bay Area Crime Stoppers. These tips are received at Crime Stoppers through phone or online. DEOs are then forwarded these tips for follow-up.

Information Bulletin

❖ Park hours

- Reminder, Memorial Park hours for the public are from **8:00 a.m. – 10:00 p.m.** No person shall be present in the park after hours. Parking ordinances are also enforced within the park after hours.

❖ Off-the-road vehicles

- Reminder, **Village code 208-18** states “No person shall ride or operate, or permit a child to operate, any bicycle, minibike, trail bike, all-terrain vehicle or other vehicle except in areas specially designated for its use” – Other vehicles include golf carts.

Crime Prevention

❖ House Check Requests

- Remember, if you're leaving town for a weekend or taking a vacation or traveling –fill out a house check request form; it can be located on the village website. These forms are forwarded to DEOs for documentation, checks, and extra patrol. These checks offer extra supervision over your home and provide DEOs information on who to contact while you are away if needed as well as what to expect for activity/vehicles at your home.

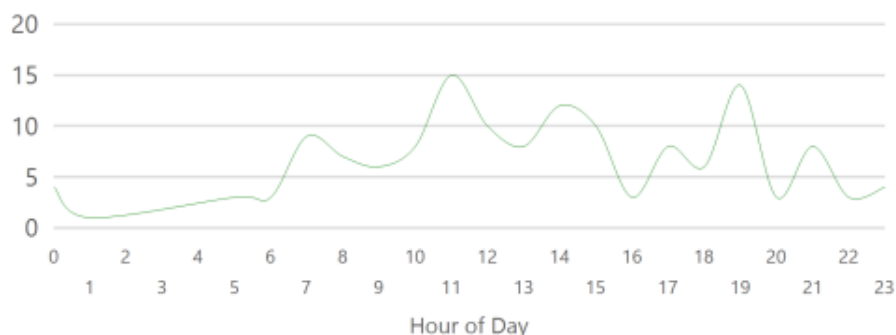

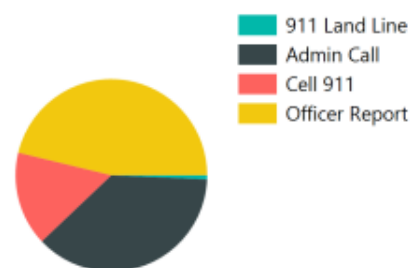
