

# Village of Denmark Police

## Summary

- ❖ **108** calls for service in the Village of Denmark from 10/1/2024 – 10/31/2024
- ❖ Brown County Sheriff's Office (BCSO) deputies provide additional enforcement, police services and respond to calls for service when DEOs are not available.

## In the Community

- ❖ **PRESCRIPTION DRUG TAKE BACK** – As a reminder, this drop off site is open Monday – Friday during normal Village of Denmark municipal hours.
- ❖ **Coffee with a Cop** – Denmark Officers will be at DeGrand Family Restaurant for Coffee with a Cop generally the first Tuesday of the month from 8-9 AM. The next event will be **Thursday, November 14, 2024**. Coffee with a Cop has been relocated to the new Community Center (formerly the Senior Center) at 141 Highridge Ave. Residents can come in to ask questions, voice their concerns, and get to know the Village Officers!
- ❖ **Drug Take Back** – Denmark DEO's participated in National Drug Take Back on 10/26
- ❖ **Trunk or Treat** – DEO Rusk participated in this year's Trunk or Treat Event at the Elementary School
- ❖ **Open House Event** - DEO Rusk attended Open House at 141 Highridge Ave for the new Community Center

## Meetings, Associations & Presentations.

- ❖ Denmark Municipal Court is scheduled for **November 6, 2024**, at **6:30PM**. Denmark Municipal Court is normally scheduled for the first Wednesday of the month at 6:30 PM (subject to change).

## Traffic / Ordinance Enforcement

- ❖ Officers use **traffic enforcement** as one mean to modify, correct and educate operators on dangerous driving behavior. Traffic citations are issued to gain compliance with the law.
  - There were **16** traffic contacts initiated and **5** traffic crashes in the Village of Denmark.
    - Of those traffic contacts, **11** traffic citations were issued, and **15** traffic warnings were issued.
    - **1** OWI arrests / citations.
- ❖ **Ordinance citations** are used to enforce the codes that are specific to Denmark. There were **12** ordinance citations issued.

## Administrative

- ❖ Denmark DEO's actively assist BCSO Investigative Division with investigations in the Village.

❖ **Significant Calls for Service:**

- **Domestic Disturbance** – BCSO Deputies responded to a residence in the Village for a domestic disturbance that resulted in an arrest and criminal charges.
- **Domestic Disturbance** – BCSO Deputies responded to the Village for a domestic disturbance that resulted in an arrest for domestic charges and operating while intoxicated.
- **Disturbance at Kwik Trip** – BCSO deputies responded to Kwik Trip for a physical disturbance/fight between two parties in the parking lot. The parties involved were issued citations and released.
- **Possible Burglary in Progress** – BCSO Deputies responded to a residence for a possible burglary in progress call. The reporting person indicated that there was possibly someone on the roof of the residence or in the attic trying to get in. Deputies responded and cleared the residence. Nobody was located in, on, or near the residence.
- **Suspicious Person** – BCSO Deputies responded to the Village for an intoxicated male walking around screaming. The male was located laying in the road on CTH R and DePere Rd extremely intoxicated. An investigation discovered the male had been damaging property in the area. Personal cameras showed that the male threw a pumpkin at someone's car and threw Halloween decorations around. The male was arrested for Criminal Damage to Property.
- **Financial Card Crime** – DEO Rusk responded to a fraud call. The victim's debit card was used without their consent for purchases at businesses in the Village. The suspect was located and issued two ordinance citations.
- **Accident with Injury** – BCSO Deputies responded to a one vehicle crash on CTH KB/Grand Ave. The vehicle left the roadway and struck a tree causing minor injuries to the driver.
- **Accident with Injury** – DEO Pigeon and BCSO Deputies responded to a two-vehicle accident with injuries at Jorgensen and Pine. One citation for failing to stop at a stop sign was issued.
- **Domestic Disturbance** – BCSO Deputies responded to a residence in the Village for a physical disturbance. This call resulted in a TASER deployment and two arrests for domestic violence related charges. Follow up by DEO Rusk and DEO Pigeon resulted in a citation to one involved party for a sex offender living in a restricted zone.
- **Domestic Disturbance** – DEP Pigeon and BCSO deputies responded to the Village for a Domestic Disturbance that resulted in an arrest for domestic violence related charges.

❖ **Chronic Nuisance Properties (CNP)**

- Currently, there are 0 properties deemed a CNP in the Village of Denmark. There is a second residence being investigated as another chronic nuisance.
- DEO's working with Landlord(s)/tenants.

❖ **Sex Offender Registrants**

- Currently there are no active Sex Offender Residency Appeals.
- Currently 0 Sex Offender (pending) Appeal process for Residency within the Village.

❖ **Patrol Vehicles/Equipment**

- The speed board has been placed on Woodrow St and Oak St due to speeding complaints in the area.
- Looking in to a potentially new squad car to replace the dark gray Dodge Durango.

## Joint Efforts

### ❖ Crime Stoppers

- Both DEOs continue to monitor anonymous tips that come in through Green Bay Area Crime Stoppers. These tips are received at Crime Stoppers through phone or online. DEOs are then forwarded these tips for follow-up.

## Information Bulletin

### ❖ Park hours

- Reminder, Memorial Park hours for the public are from **8:00 a.m. – 10:00 p.m.** No person shall be present in the park after hours. Parking ordinances are also enforced within the park after hours.

### ❖ Nighttime Parking Prohibited

- Village Code 289-5(B) states: (1) No person shall park any vehicle between 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. from November 1 to April 1 on any Village street. (2) No person shall park any vehicle between 3:00 a.m. and 5:00 a.m. without a permit from the Village on the Village of Denmark Central Business District Parking Lot.

### ❖ Off-the-road vehicles

- Reminder, **Village code 208-18** states “No person shall ride or operate, or permit a child to operate, any bicycle, minibike, trail bike, all-terrain vehicle or other vehicle except in areas specially designated for its use” – Other vehicles include golf carts.

## Crime Prevention

### ❖ House Check Requests

- Remember, if you're leaving town for a weekend or taking a vacation or traveling –fill out a house check request form; it can be located on the village website. These forms are forwarded to DEOs for documentation, checks, and extra patrol. These checks offer extra supervision over your home and provide DEOs information on who to contact while you are away if needed as well as what to expect for activity/vehicles at your home.

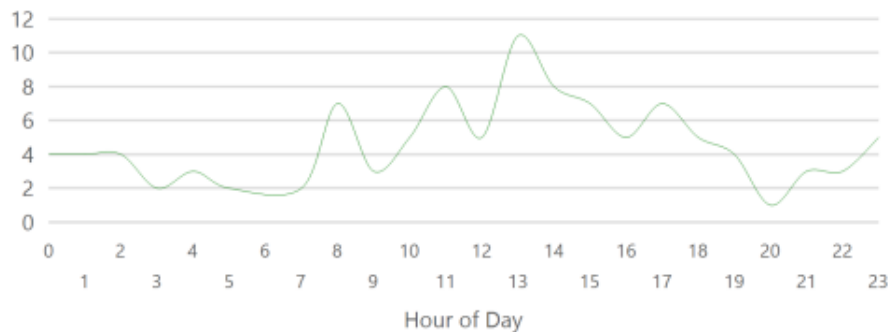

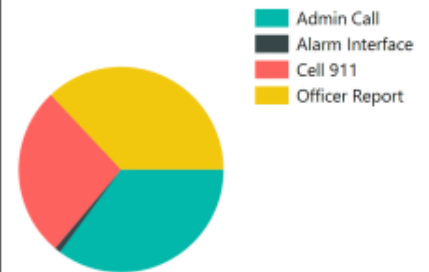
