Summary

- ❖ **100** calls for service in the Village of Denmark from **4/1/2025 – 4/30/2025**
- ❖ Brown County Sheriff's Office (BCSO) deputies provide additional enforcement, police services and respond to calls for service when DEOs are not available.

In the Community

- ❖ **PRESCRIPTION DRUG TAKE BACK** – As a reminder, this drop off site is open Monday – Friday during normal Village of Denmark municipal hours.
- ❖ **Coffee with a Cop** – DEO Rusk will be at the Denmark Community Center (141 Highridge Ave) for Coffee with a Cop and Brunch with Denmark Connects on **Wednesday, May 21, 2025, around 12:00 PM**. Residents are welcome to come in to ask questions, voice their concerns, and get to know the Village Officers!
- ❖ **Rummage Sale Weekend** – Rummage sale weekend was May 3-5. Hopefully all participants had the success they were hoping for. The sales went on with minimal issues.
- ❖ **Crossing Guard Service Proposal** – DEO Rusk received a service proposal from "All City Management Solutions" for outsourcing crossing guard services to their company. The proposal cost would include recruitment, background investigations, training, equipment, insurance, supervision, and management of the Village Crossing Guard Program.

Meetings, Associations & Presentations.

- ❖ Denmark Municipal Court is scheduled for **June 4, 2025, at 6:30PM**. Denmark Municipal Court is normally scheduled for the first Wednesday of the month at 6:30 PM (subject to change).

Traffic / Ordinance Enforcement

- ❖ Officers use **traffic enforcement** as one mean to modify, correct and educate operators on dangerous driving behavior. Traffic citations are issued to gain compliance with the law.
 - There were **18** traffic contacts initiated and **1** traffic crash in the Village of Denmark.
 - Of those traffic contacts, **10** traffic citations were issued, and **18** traffic warnings were issued.
 - **0** OWI arrests / citations.
- ❖ **Ordinance citations** are used to enforce the codes that are specific to Denmark. There were **4** ordinance citations issued.

Administrative

- ❖ **Denmark DEO's actively assist BCSO Investigative Division with investigations in the Village.**
- ❖ **Significant Calls for Service:**
 - **Domestic Disturbances** – BCSO Deputies responded to the Village for two separate disturbances that resulted in an arrest and Domestic Violence related charges.
 - **Suspicious Situation** – Brown County Deputies responded to the Village for a suspicious situation at the Cobblestone Hotel. This incident was investigated and nothing suspicious was observed by Deputies and all parties were cooperative.
 - **Disturbance/Possible Weapon Call** – DEO Pigeon was dispatched to an address in the Village for a disturbance where one subject allegedly made a threat to use a weapon. One of the parties involved was taken into custody for a warrant. This incident resulted in no further police action being taken.
- ❖ **Chronic Nuisance Properties (CNP)**
 - Currently, there are **0** properties deemed a CNP in the Village of Denmark. There is a second residence being investigated as another chronic nuisance.
 - DEO's working with Landlord(s)/tenants.
- ❖ **Sex Offender Registrants**
 - Currently there are no active Sex Offender Residency Appeals.
 - Currently **1** Sex Offender (pending) Appeal process for Residency within the Village.
- ❖ **Patrol Vehicles/Equipment**
 - The new black Durango has arrived, and the changeover will be coordinated with the Brown County Sheriff's Office Mechanic.
 - New squad radio is in and being programmed by Frank's Radio in Manitowoc
 - Most equipment from the gray Durango should work in the new one and can be changed over. As of now, the only thing that needs to be purchased is a new center console because the gray Durango has a center console shifter, and the new squad will have a column shifter.

Joint Efforts

- ❖ **Crime Stoppers**
 - Both DEOs continue to monitor anonymous tips that come in through Green Bay Area Crime Stoppers. These tips are received at Crime Stoppers through phone or online. DEOs are then forwarded these tips for follow-up.

Information Bulletin

❖ Park hours

- Reminder, Memorial Park hours for the public are from **8:00 a.m. – 10:00 p.m.** No person shall be present **Off-the-road vehicles**
- Reminder, **Village code 208-18** states “No person shall ride or operate, or permit a child to operate, any bicycle, minibike, trail bike, all-terrain vehicle or other vehicle except in areas specially designated for its use”

Crime Prevention

❖ House Check Requests

- Remember, if you're leaving town for a weekend or taking a vacation or traveling –fill out a house check request form; it can be located on the village website. These forms are forwarded to DEOs for documentation, checks, and extra patrol. These checks offer extra supervision over your home and provide DEOs information on who to contact while you are away if needed as well as what to expect for activity/vehicles at your home.

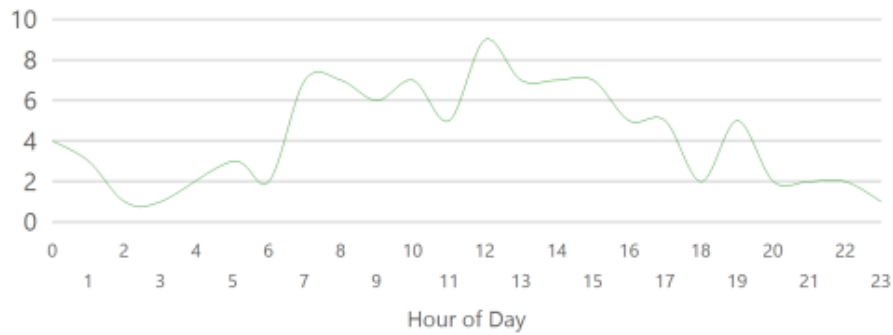

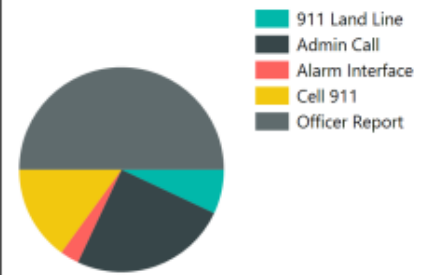
