## Summary

- ❖ **124** calls for service in the Village of Denmark from **8/1/2025 – 8/31/2025**
- ❖ Brown County Sheriff's Office (BCSO) deputies provide additional enforcement, police services and respond to calls for service when DEOs are not available.

## In the Community

- ❖ **PRESCRIPTION DRUG TAKE BACK** – As a reminder, this drop off site is open Monday – Friday during normal Village of Denmark municipal hours.
- ❖ **New Crossing Guard** – Please welcome our new part time Crossing Guard Kathy Waldron! Kathy will be working the afternoon shift.
- ❖ **Golf Carts** – Golf carts are now allowed to be driven on Village streets. Golf cart registration information is at the Denmark Village Hall, 100 N Wall St.

## Meetings, Associations & Presentations.

- ❖ Denmark Municipal Court is scheduled for **October 1, 2025**, at **6:30PM**. Denmark Municipal Court is normally scheduled for the first Wednesday of the month at 6:30 PM (subject to change).

## Traffic / Ordinance Enforcement

- ❖ Officers use **traffic enforcement** as one mean to modify, correct and educate operators on dangerous driving behavior. Traffic citations are issued to gain compliance with the law.
  - There were **22** traffic contacts initiated and **2** traffic crashes in the Village of Denmark.
    - Of those traffic contacts, **22** traffic citations were issued, and **28** traffic warnings were issued.
    - **3 OWI** arrests / citations.
- ❖ **Ordinance citations** are used to enforce the codes that are specific to Denmark. There were **3** ordinance citations issued.

## Administrative

- ❖ Denmark DEO's actively assist BCSO Investigative Division with investigations in the Village.
- ❖ **Significant Calls for Service:**

- **Suspicious Person/Criminal Damage to Property** – DEO Pigeon observed a male spray painting one of the buildings at Memorial Park and confronted the individual. The individual was issued citations for disorderly conduct and damage to property in a park and released.
- **Accident with Injury** – BCSO Deputies responded to a vehicle vs pole crash on Green Bay Rd. The driver ran to a nearby residence. Deputies made contact with the male at the residence and the driver was subsequently arrested for Operating While Intoxicated
- **Damage to Property** – DEO Rusk responded to a business in the Village for a vehicle was damaged by keying. The male suspect was identified and admitted to causing the damage. The male suspect was cited for Criminal Damage to Property.
- **Accident Call** – A semi making a delivery to Melotte Distributing hit the fence/mechanical door at the Water Treatment Plant causing significant damage to the property. DEO and DPW director are working with the business that caused the damage. Follow up will be completed for this incident.
- **Warrants** – Two warrants arrest warrants were executed in the Village. Both warrants involved individuals with extensive criminal backgrounds.
- ❖ **Chronic Nuisance Properties (CNP)**
  - Currently, there are **1** properties deemed a CNP in the Village of Denmark. There is a second residence being investigated as another chronic nuisance.
  - DEO's working with Landlord(s)/tenants.
- ❖ **Sex Offender Registrants**
  - Currently there are no active Sex Offender Residency Appeals.
- ❖ **Patrol Vehicles/Equipment**
  - There has been a lot of progress on the new black Durango. It will be on patrol in the near future, and the gray Durango will be able to be sold.

## Joint Efforts

- ❖ **Crime Stoppers**
  - Both DEOs continue to monitor anonymous tips that come in through Green Bay Area Crime Stoppers. These tips are received at Crime Stoppers through phone or online. DEOs are then forwarded these tips for follow-up.

These forms are forwarded to DEOs for documentation, checks, and extra patrol. These checks offer extra supervision over your home and provide DEOs information on who to contact while you are away if needed as well as what to expect for activity/vehicles at your home.

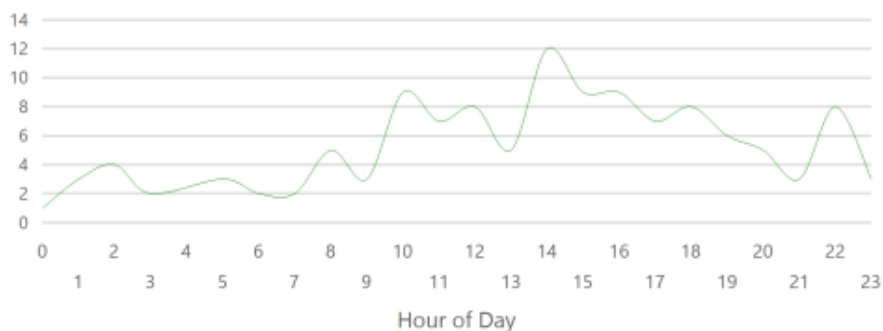

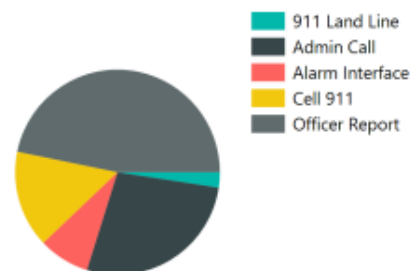
