Summary

- ❖ 122 calls for service in the Village of Denmark from 7/1/2025 7/31/2025
- Brown County Sheriff's Office (BCSO) deputies provide additional enforcement, police services and respond to calls for service when DEOs are not available.

In the Community

- ❖ PRESCRIPTION DRUG TAKE BACK As a reminder, this drop off site is open Monday Friday during normal Village of Denmark municipal hours.
- ❖ Coffee with a Cop DEO Rusk will be at the Denmark Community Center (141 Highridge Ave) for Coffee with a Cop and Brunch with Denmark Connects on Wednesday, August 20, 2025, around 12:00 PM. Residents are welcome to come in to ask questions, voice their concerns, and get to know the Village Officers!
- ❖ Golf Carts Golf carts are now allowed to be driven on Village streets. Golf cart registration information is at the Denmark Village Hall, 100 N Wall St.
- ❖ Electric Scooters Please encourage children to utilize safe practices while they are using electric scooters (helmets, protective equipment, close toe shoes, etc). Electric scooter users are required to follow all the rules of the road.
- ❖ Speed Board The speed board was placed on S Wall St. due to speeding complaints in the area.
- RRFB's DEO Rusk received quotes for placing RRFB's at the intersections of Highridge/N Wall St and N Wall St/Main St. The RRFB's would replace crossing guards at these locations.
- Alarms The Denmark Village board has approved the billing of excessive alarm responses to properties in the Village.
- ❖ Denmark Lions Parade/Picnic The Lions Parade/Picnic was held on July 27. DEO's and County Deputies were present with the Brown County Sheriff's Office Bearcat armored vehicle and a K9 demonstration for attendees.

Meetings, Associations & Presentations.

Denmark Municipal Court is scheduled for September 3, 2025, at 6:30PM. Denmark Municipal Court is normally scheduled for the first Wednesday of the month at 6:30 PM (subject to change).

Traffic / Ordinance Enforcement

- Officers use traffic enforcement as one mean to modify, correct and educate operators on dangerous driving behavior. Traffic citations are issued to gain compliance with the law.
 - o There were 15 traffic contacts initiated and 2 traffic crashes in the Village of Denmark.
 - Of those traffic contacts, 14 traffic citations were issued, and 12 traffic warnings were issued.
 - 1 OWI arrests / citations.
- Ordinance citations are used to enforce the codes that are specific to Denmark. There were 2 ordinance <u>citations</u> issued.

Administrative

- ❖ Denmark DEO's actively assist BCSO Investigative Division with investigations in the Village.
- Significant Calls for Service:
 - Criminal Damage to Property DEO Pigeon responded to an address in the Village for a damage complaint. The complainant stated that they lent their vehicle to a friend who did not want to return the vehicle. The vehicle was damaged prior to being returned.
 - Disturbance/Bar Fight BCSO Deputies responded to the Village for a disturbance at a local tavern
 where the complainant reported being punched in the face numerous times.
 - Retail Theft DEO Pigeon and BCSO Deputies responded to a retail theft at O'Reily Auto Parts. The suspect was identified and cited.
 - Vehicle Crash At McDonald's a vehicle crashed into the fence on the property. The driver was identified and issued citations.
 - Hit and Run Crash DEO Rusk took a complaint a crash in the parking lot of Family Dollar. The suspect
 driver struck a parked vehicle and drove away. This crash is still being investigated.
 - Domestic Disturbance BCSO Deputies responded to a residence in the Village for a disturbance. This
 call resulted in an arrest for domestic violence related charges.

Chronic Nuisance Properties (CNP)

- Currently, there are 0 properties deemed a CNP in the Village of Denmark. There is a second residence being investigated as another chronic nuisance.
- o DEO's working with Landlord(s)/tenants.

Sex Offender Registrants

- Currently there are no active Sex Offender Residency Appeals.
- Currently 0 Sex Offender (pending) Appeal process for Residency within the Village.

❖ Patrol Vehicles/Equipment

- The new black Durango changeover is nearly completed.
- The white Durango was recently at Gandrud for two recalls and a repair to the gas tank. The work has been completed.

The rear lights on the new Durango have been modified to be internal opposed to external lights. This
avoids the need to drill into the C-Pillar of the squad to mount the external lights.

- Both DEOs continue to monitor anonymous tips that come in through Green Bay Area Crime Stoppers.

 These tips are received at Crime Stoppers through phone or online. DEOs are then forwarded these tips for follow-up.


House Check Requests


