Summary

- ❖ **92** calls for service in the Village of Denmark from **6/1/2025 – 6/30/2025**
- ❖ Brown County Sheriff's Office (BCSO) deputies provide additional enforcement, police services and respond to calls for service when DEOs are not available.

In the Community

- ❖ **PRESCRIPTION DRUG TAKE BACK** – As a reminder, this drop off site is open Monday – Friday during normal Village of Denmark municipal hours.
- ❖ **Coffee with a Cop** – DEO Rusk will be at the Denmark Community Center (141 Highridge Ave) for Coffee with a Cop and Brunch with Denmark Connects on **Wednesday, August 20, 2025, around 12:00 PM**. Residents are welcome to come in to ask questions, voice their concerns, and get to know the Village Officers!
- ❖ **Golf Carts** – Golf carts are now allowed to be driven on Village streets. Golf cart registration information is at the Denmark Village Hall, 100 N Wall St.
- ❖ **Electric Scooters** – Please encourage children to utilize safe practices while they are using electric scooters (helmets, protective equipment, close toe shoes, etc). Electric scooter users are required to follow all the rules of the road.
- ❖ **Speed Board** – The speed board was placed on Broadway St recently to gather traffic statistics. Now that the requested data has been collected, the speed board has been moved to S Wall St due to speed complaints in the area.

Meetings, Associations & Presentations.

- ❖ Denmark Municipal Court is scheduled for **August 6, 2025**, at **6:30PM**. Denmark Municipal Court is normally scheduled for the first Wednesday of the month at 6:30 PM (subject to change).

Traffic / Ordinance Enforcement

- ❖ Officers use **traffic enforcement** as one mean to modify, correct and educate operators on dangerous driving behavior. Traffic citations are issued to gain compliance with the law.
 - There were **25** traffic contacts initiated and **2** traffic crashes in the Village of Denmark.
 - Of those traffic contacts, **11** traffic citations were issued, and **28** traffic warnings were issued.
 - **0** OWI arrests / citations.

- ❖ **Ordinance citations** are used to enforce the codes that are specific to Denmark. There were **8** ordinance citations issued.

Administrative

- ❖ **Denmark DEO's actively assist BCSO Investigative Division with investigations in the Village.**
- ❖ **Significant Calls for Service:**
 - **Disturbance** – BCSO Deputies and DEO Pigeon responded to the Village for a disturbance. The complainant called because they could hear items being thrown around and people yelling at each other. When deputies arrived, a female came outside and was very animated. There was also a broken window observed on the front of the building. Parties involved were uncooperative the night of the disturbance and no contact was made. The involved parties were eventually identified and both were issued citations for disorderly conduct and criminal damage to property.
 - **Disturbance** – DEO Pigeon and DEO Rusk responded to a residence in the Village for a disturbance that resulted in an arrest for domestic violence related charges.
 - **Suspicious Situation** – DEO Rusk responded to a suspicious situation where the complainant believed someone just stole a vehicle from the Kwik Trip parking lot. DEO Rusk was able to locate the vehicle and made contact with the driver. It was discovered that the driver was there picking up their spouse and left the store for a brief period. Nothing suspicious was observed.
 - **Hit and Run Crashes** – There were two separate hit and run crashes in the Kwik Trip parking lot.
- ❖ **Chronic Nuisance Properties (CNP)**
 - Currently, there are **0** properties deemed a CNP in the Village of Denmark. There is a second residence being investigated as another chronic nuisance.
 - DEO's working with Landlord(s)/tenants.
- ❖ **Sex Offender Registrants**
 - Currently there are no active Sex Offender Residency Appeals.
 - Currently **1** Sex Offender (pending) Appeal process for Residency within the Village. DEO Rusk is waiting for additional information from the party.
 - One party was cited for living in the Village in violation of Sex Offender Residency Requirements.
- ❖ **Patrol Vehicles/Equipment**
 - The new black Durango will be changed over in the coming weeks.
 - The white Durango was recently at Gandrud for two recalls and a repair to the gas tank.

Joint Efforts

- ❖ **Crime Stoppers**
 - Both DEOs continue to monitor anonymous tips that come in through Green Bay Area Crime Stoppers. These tips are received at Crime Stoppers through phone or online. DEOs are then forwarded these tips for follow-up.

These checks offer extra supervision over your home and provide DEOs information on who to contact while you are away if needed as well as what to expect for activity/vehicles at your home.

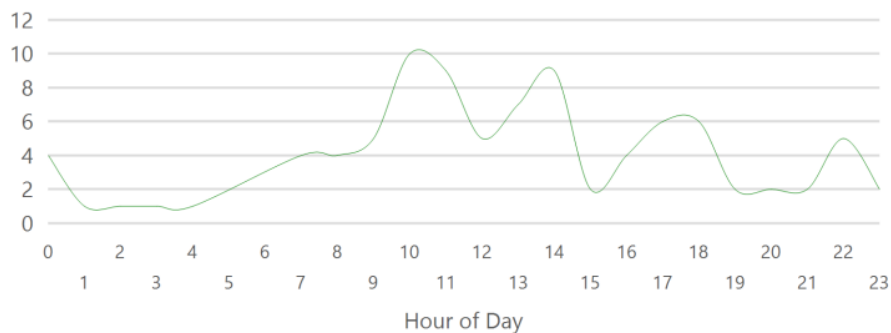

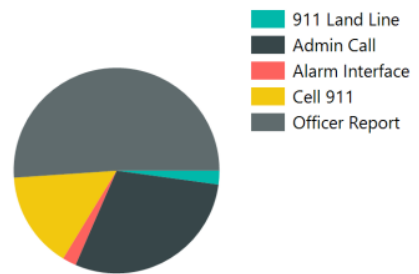
