

# Village of Denmark Police

## Summary

- ❖ **112** calls for service in the Village of Denmark from **11/1/2025 – 11/30/2025**
- ❖ Brown County Sheriff's Office (BCSO) deputies provide additional enforcement, police services and respond to calls for service when DEOs are not available.

## In the Community

- ❖ **PRESCRIPTION DRUG TAKE BACK** - As a reminder, this drop off site is open Monday – Friday during normal Village of Denmark municipal hours.
- ❖ **Golf Carts** – Reminder: golf carts are not allowed on Village streets during winter months.
- ❖ **Overnight Parking** – Beginning on November 1, parking on the street overnight is prohibited in the Village until April 1.

## Meetings, Associations & Presentations.

- ❖ Denmark Municipal Court is scheduled for **January 7, 2026, at 6:30PM**. Denmark Municipal Court is normally scheduled for the first Wednesday of the month at 6:30 PM (subject to change).

## Traffic / Ordinance Enforcement

- ❖ Officers use **traffic enforcement** as one mean to modify, correct and educate operators on dangerous driving behavior. Traffic citations are issued to gain compliance with the law.
  - There were **6** traffic contacts initiated and **10** traffic crashes in the Village of Denmark.
    - Of those traffic contacts, **7** traffic citations were issued, and **4** traffic warnings were issued.
    - **0 OWI** arrests / citations.
- ❖ **Ordinance citations** are used to enforce the codes that are specific to Denmark. There were **18** ordinance citations issued. Most ordinance citations were violations of the overnight parking ordinance.

## Administrative

- ❖ Denmark DEO's actively assist BCSO Investigative Division with investigations in the Village.
- ❖ **Significant Calls for Service:**

- **Fatal Crash** – Numerous Brown County deputies responded to I-43 SB and STH 96 on Thanksgiving night for a fatal crash. This crash resulted in an arrest for Homicide by Intoxicated Use of a Motor Vehicle, OWI Causing Injury, and operating the wrong way on a divided highway. This case is still under investigation by the Brown County Sheriff's Office Crash Reconstruction Unit and Brown County Sheriff's Office Investigators.
- **Hit and Run** – BCSO deputies responded to a hit and run to an unattended parked vehicle. The suspect was located, identified, and cited.
- **Suspicious Person** – BCSO night shift responded to a suspicious person complaint. The caller reported that unknown male was sitting on their front porch at 2:30 AM. Deputies made contact with the male and found that he was intoxicated and went to the wrong house. He was brought home safely.
- **Bank Fraud/Identity Theft** – A suspect went into Bank First and impersonated a customer to obtain money from the bank fraudulently. This incident is still being investigated.
- **Disturbance/Drugs** – Brown County Sheriff's Office Deputies responded to a residence in the Village for a disturbance. This incident resulted in an arrest for Disorderly Conduct, Possession of Narcotic Drugs, and felony bail jumping.
- ❖ **Chronic Nuisance Properties (CNP)**
  - Currently, there are **1** property deemed a CNP in the Village of Denmark.
  - DEO's working with Landlord(s)/tenants.
- ❖ **Sex Offender Registrants**
  - Currently there are no active Sex Offender Residency Appeals, but there have been two inquiries.
- ❖ **Patrol Vehicles/Equipment**
  - A new RADAR unit has been ordered for the white Durango. The current RADAR quit working and is very out of date, so a new one was required.
  - BC Highway Department has approved the RRFB's, and are working with Village DPW for installation.

## Joint Efforts

- ❖ **Crime Stoppers**
  - Both DEOs continue to monitor anonymous tips that come in through Green Bay Area Crime Stoppers. These tips are received at Crime Stoppers through phone or online. DEOs are then forwarded these tips for follow-up.

These forms are forwarded to DEOs for documentation, checks, and extra patrol. These checks offer extra supervision over your home and provide DEOs information on who to contact while you are away if needed as well as what to expect for activity/vehicles at your home.




