
The Town Board of the Town of Sturgeon Bay, Door County, Wisconsin has the specific authority under 7.30 (1), Wis. stats., to adopt the following:


This resolution, adopted by a majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, provides for the selection of two (2) sets of officials to work at different times on each election day (not including the Chief Election Inspector).


- A. There could be two shifts for election workers on all election days. The first shift shall commence at 6:30 a.m. and end at 1:30 p.m. The second shift shall commence at 1:30 p.m. and end with completion of all required election day duties that follow the closure of the polls.
- B. The split shift requirements will not apply to an election greeter, to answer questions and to direct electors to the proper locations for registration and voting.
