

348.16, 349.15, and 349.16 * Ordinance establishing special or seasonal weight limits.

Town of How
Deonte County

The Town Board of the Town of How, Deonte County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority under s. 349.16, Wis. stats., to adopt this ordinance.

The Town Board of the Town of How, by this ordinance, adopted on proper notice with a quorum and by a roll call vote by a majority of the town board present and voting, provides the authority for the town to establish special or seasonal weight limits as follows:

- A. The following seasonal or special weight limits shall be effective for the periods stated below on the following Town of How town highways, which are declared to be class "B" highways under s. 349.15 (2), Wis. stats.: *[list individual town highways, applicable weight limits, and dates weight limits are to be in effect]*
- B. The town chairperson, or his or her designee shall erect signs as required under s. 349.16 (2), Wis. stats., on or before the effective date of this ordinance.
- C. No person may operate any vehicle on the above-noted highways, in violation of the above-noted weight limits, without a written permit issued by the Town Board of the Town of How. Any violation shall be subject to penalties under s. 348.21, Wis. stats.

This ordinance is effective on [publication or posting or March 19, 2010 specific date after the date of publication or posting date allowing adequate time for erection of signs.]

The town clerk shall properly post or publish this ordinance as required under s. 60.80, Wis. stats.

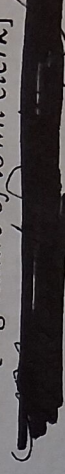
