Chapter 9

ANIMALS

ARTICLE I Dog Control [Adopted 4-9-1974 by Ord. No. 1-1974¹]

§ 9-1. Intent.

It is the general intent of this article to regulate and restrict the keeping and/or harboring of dogs within the Town of Scott, County of Sheboygan, State of Wisconsin, so as to lessen congestion and to promote safety, stabilization and protection of property values, conservation of natural resources, and preservation of the beauty of the community.

§ 9-2. Restrictions.

- A. It shall be unlawful for any person to harbor or permit to remain about his premises any dog for which no license exists and for which one is required.
- B. It shall be unlawful for the owner or keeper of any dog to permit such dog to enter and roam on the premises of another, unless accompanied by the owner or keeper, and the owner or keeper has obtained permission to enter and trespass on the property.
- C. It shall be unlawful for any person to keep or harbor within the limits of the Town of Scott any dog which frequently or habitually barks, yells, or howls.

§ 9-3. Violations and penalties.

- A. Any person violating any provisions of this article shall be subject to a forfeiture of not more than \$50.2
- B. Each day that the provisions of this article are violated shall be and constitute a separate offense hereunder.

ARTICLE II Late Fee for Dog and Kennel Licenses [Adopted 8-14-1986 by Ord. No. 4-1986³]

§ 9-4. Dog licenses. ⁴

A late fee in the amount as prescribed in the Town Fee Schedule shall be collected from every owner of a dog five months of age or over if the owner fails to obtain a license for said dog prior to April 1 of each year or within 30 days of acquiring ownership of a licensable dog or if the owner fails to obtain a license on or before the dog reaches licensable age (five months). The current Town Fee Schedule is on file at the office of the Town Clerk.

§ 9-5. Kennel licenses. ⁵

A late fee in the amount as prescribed in the Town Fee Schedule shall be collected from the owner of a kennel who fails to obtain a kennel license prior to April 1 of each year or within 30 days of establishing or acquiring a kennel. The current Town Fee Schedule is on file at the office of the Town Clerk.
