VILLAGE OF AUGUSTA, MICHIGAN ORDINANCE NO. 177 OBSTRUCTION

An Ordinance to prohibit the obstruction of a police officer or ordinance enforcement officer in the performance of their duties by disguising or providing false information; and to provide a penalty for the violation thereof.

THE VILLAGE OF AUGUSTA KALAMAZOO COUNTY, MICHIGAN ORDAINS:

SECTION I TITLE

This Ordinance shall be known as the Village of Augusta Obstructing by Disguise or False Information Ordinance.

SECTION II OBSTRUCTING BY DISGUISE OR FALSE INFORMATION

A person shall not in any manner disguise himself or herself, or provide a false or fictitious name or other false information to a police officer or ordinance enforcement officer, with intent to obstruct the officer in the performance of his or her duty, whether such intent be effected or not.

SECTION III PENALTY

Violation of this Ordinance shall be judged a misdemeanor punishable by a fine of not more than \$500 or imprisonment in the county jail not to exceed 90 days or both fine and imprisonment.

SECTION IV REPEAL

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION V EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance shall take effect upon the date of its publication, which shall be within 15 days after its adoption.
