ORDINANCE NO. 104

ADOPTED: NOVEMBER 24, 1969

EFFECTIVE: NOVEMBER 24, 1969

An Ordinance to amend Section 2 of Ordinance No. 82 pertaining to overnight parking upon the streets within the Village of Augusta and to repeal all ordinances in conflict herewith.

THE VILLAGE OF AUGUSTA, KALAMAZOO COUNTY
MICHIGAN, ORDAINS:

Section 1. Section 2 of Ordinance No. 82 enacted on the 13th day of December, 1965, and effective on the 4th day of January 1966, pertaining to overnight parking upon the streets within the Village of Augusta be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 2. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to park or leave standing unattended any motor vehicle or other vehicle within 20 feet of the center of any street or upon the paved portion of any public street or sidewalk within the Village of Augusta, between the hours of 2:00 A.M. and 6:00 o'clock A.M.

Section 3. Severability. The provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable and if any clause, sentence, paragraph, section or subsection is declared void or inoperable for any reason, it shall not affect any part or portion thereof.

Section 4. Any Ordinance or part of an Ordinance in conflict therewith is hereby repealed.

Section 5. This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency enactment and shall take immediate effect.
