

VILLAGE OF AUGUSTA ORDINANCE No. 106

ADOPTED: February 8, 1971

EFFECTIVE: March 1, 1971

An Ordinance to amend Section 1 of Ordinance No. 99, which was adopted by the Village of Augusta Board of Trustees February 17, 1969.

THE VILLAGE OF AUGUSTA, KALAMAZOO COUNTY, MICHIGAN,

ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. The salaries for the following officials of the Village of Augusta for the term or terms beginning March 1, 1971 shall be:

- A. Village Clerk - \$3,000.00 yearly
- B. Village Treasurer - \$1,700.00 yearly
- C. Village Assessor - \$400.00 yearly

Section 2. Any Ordinance or part of an Ordinance in conflict herewith is hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. Severability. The provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable. If any clause, sentence, paragraph, section or sections is declared void or inoperable by any reason, it shall not affect any other part or portion thereof.
