ORDINANCE # 101

ADOPTED: May 26, 1969

EFFECTIVE: June 24, 1969

An ordinance to amend Ordinance No. 60 relative to the dumping of garbage, rubbish or waste material and to amend and revoke any other ordinances, or parts of ordinances, in conflict herewith:

THE VILLAGE OF AUGUSTA, KALAMAZOO COUNTY,

MICHIGAN, ORDAINS:

Section 1. Ordinance No. 60, enacted on the 13th day of November, 1950, entitled, "An Ordinance to Prohibit the Dumping of Garbage", be and the same is hereby amended by adding thereto and inserting therein, following Section 2, thereof, the following to be known as Section 2 (a):

"Section 2 (a). No person, firm or corporation shall permit any garbage, rubbish, junk, debris, waste material, combustible material or other miscellaneous, unused, unsanitary or dangerous material or valueless equipment, or any other source of filth or cause of sickness, to accumulate in unreasonable or abnormal quantities in, on, or adjoining the property owned or occupied by such person, firm or corporation. It shall be the duty of every person, firm or corporation to see that property owned or occupied by such person, firm or corporation is kept free of such waste material and that any such waste material is removed immediately hereafter."

Section 2. Section 2 of said Ordinance No. 60 is hereby amended by substituting the sum of ONE HUNDRED (\$100.00) DOLLARS as a maximum fine upon conviction in place of the sum of TEN (\$10.00) DOLLARS AS a maximum fine upon conviction set forth in said section.

Section 3. Any Ordinance or part of an ordinance in conflict herewith is hereby repealed.

Section 4. Severability. The provisions of this ordinance are hereby declared to be severable. If any clause, sentence, paragraph, section or subsection is declared void or inoperable for any reason, it shall not affect any other part or portion thereof.
