ORDINANCE NO. 102

An Ordinance to repeal Section 3 of Ordinance No. 7, relative to the planting of trees within the Village.

THE VILLAGE OF AUGUSTA, KALAMAZOO COUNTY, MICHIGAN

ORDAINS:

Section 1. Section 3 of Ordinance No. 7, enacted on the 16th day of September, 1895, pertaining to the planting of trees on Village property or within 7 feet of a property line, be and the same is repealed.

Section 2. Any ordinance or part of an ordinance in conflict herewith is hereby repealed.

Section 3. Severability. The provisions of this ordinance are hereby declared to be severable. If any clause, sentence, paragraph, section or subsection is declared void or inoperable for any reason, it shall not affect any other part or portion thereof.
