

VILLAGE OF AUGUSTA ORDINANCE NO. 107

ADOPTED: February 22, 1971

EFFECTIVE: April 15, 1971

An Ordinance to prohibit the parking of motor vehicles upon the southside of Michigan Avenue (State Highway M-96) between Webster Street and East Canal Street within the Village of Augusta and to repeal all ordinances in conflict herewith.

ORDAINS:

SECTION I.

It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to park or leave standing unattended any motor vehicle or other vehicle on the southside of Michigan Avenue (State Highway M-96) between Webster Street and East Canal Street at any time.

SECTION II.

Severability. The provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable. If any clause, sentence, paragraph, section or subsection is declared void or inoperable for any reason, it shall not affect any other part or portion thereof.

SECTION III.

Any Ordinance or part of an Ordinance in conflict herewith is hereby repealed.

SECTION IV.

This Ordinance shall take affect on April 15, 1971
