

VILLAGE OF AUGUSTA ORDINANCE NO. 108

TITLE: PARKING MOTOR VEHICLES ON WEBSTER STREET

ADOPTED: March 22, 1971

EFFECTIVE: April 22, 1971

An Ordinance to prohibit the parking of vehicles for longer than two (2) hours on Webster Street from Michigan Avenue to Fayette Street within the Village of Augusta from 6:00 A.M. to 6:00 P.M. and to repeal all ordinances in conflict herewith.

ORDAINS:

SECTION 1.

It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation at any time to park or leave standing unattended for longer than two (2) hours any motor vehicle or other vehicle on either side of Webster Street from Michigan Avenue to Fayette Street within the Village of Augusta between 6:00 A. M. and 6:00 P. M.

SECTION 11.

Any Ordinance or part of an ordinance in conflict herewith is hereby repealed.
