VILLAGE OF AUGUSTA HYDRANT RENTAL ORDINANCE

Adopted: February 28, 1972

Effective: March 28, 1972

An Ordinance to amend Section 2 of Ordinance No. 105 pertaining to hydrant rental fees and to establish new hydrant rental fees.

THE VILLAGE OF AUGUSTA, KALAMAZOO COUNTY

MICHIGAN, ORDAINS:

Section 1. Section No. 2 of Ordinance No. 105, adopted on the 13th day of April, 1970, entitled "HYDRANT RENTAL ORDINANCE" is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 2. The Village of Augusta shall pay the sum of FIFTY (\$50.00) DOLLARS PER YEAR for the rental of each fire hydrant used within the Village for fire protection, said sum to assist in the improvement of the water system of the Village of Augusta.

Section 3. Any Ordinance in conflict with the provision of this Ordinance is hereby repealed.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect on March 28, 1972.
