ORDINANCE NO. 112

ADOPTED: June 25, 1973

EFFECTIVE: Immediately

An Ordinance of the Village of Augusta to prohibit the fluoridation of the Village water supply pursuant to Public Act No. 346 of the Public Acts of the State of Michigan of 1968 and to repeal all Ordinances or parts or Ordinances in conflict therewith.

THE VILLAGE OF AUGUSTA,
KALAMAZOO COUNTY, MICHIGAN,

ORDAINS:

SECTION I.

The Village of Augusta or its successor, or any person, firm or Corporation, shall not add any water fluoride or fluoride to the Village water supply system, or any part or portion thereof. The purpose of this Ordinance is to exempt the Village from the requirement of adding fluoride to the water supply of the Village as provided by Public Act No. 346 of the Public Acts of the State of Michigan of 1968 (CL 48, Section 325.210).

SECTION II.

All Ordinances of parts of Ordinances is conflict herewith are hereby repealed. This Ordinance shall take immediate effect.
