

RATE ORDINANCE
VILLAGE OF AUGUSTA
ORDINANCE NO. 120

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING RATES, CHARGES AND RULES FOR THE USE
AND SERVICE OF THE WATER SUPPLY SYSTEM OF THE VILLAGE OF AUGUST, COUNTY
OF KALAMAZOO, MICHIGAN.

THE VILLAGE OF AUGUSTA ORDAINS:

Section 1. There shall be and there is hereby established quarterly
rates and charges for the use of and for the services supplied by the
Village's Water Supply System based upon the meter readings of the amount of
water consumed, as follows:

<u>Water Rates</u>	
First 500 cubic feet	\$8.25 minimum charge
Next 1,500 cubic feet	\$.50 per 100 cubic feet
Next 2,000 cubic feet	\$.45 per 100 cubic feet
Next 6,000 cubic feet	\$.35 per 100 cubic feet
All over 10,000 cubic feet	\$.30 per 100 cubic feet

The minimum charge shall apply to each unit using water, even though
several units using water are connected to one meter.

Hydrant Rental: The Village shall pay the sum of \$2,050 per year for fire
protection for the Village-at-large.

Special Rates

For miscellaneous services for which a special rate
shall be established such rates shall be fixed by the
Village Council.

Turn on Charges

There will be imposed a charge of \$5.00 whenever the
Village is requested to turn on or off water services:
Provided, however, whenever the Village is requested
to provide turn on or off service at times other than
the regular business hours of the Village there will be
imposed an additional charge of time and material plus
10%.

Section 2. Bills for the rates and charges as herein established by the Village shall be sent quarterly. All bills shall be payable within 30 days following the receipt of the bill, and shall be paid at the office of the Treasurer of the Village of Augusta. If any charge for the services of the system shall not be paid within 30 days following receipt of the bill when it shall become due and payable, a delayed payment charge of ten per cent (10%) of the amount of the bill shall be added thereto and collected therewith. If any bills for the service of the system shall remain unpaid after 60 days following the rendition of the bill therefore, the water supply for the lot, parcel of land, or premise affected shall be cut off and shall not be turned on again except on payment in full of the delinquent charges therefor, in addition to the payment of a charge of \$10.00.

Section 3. It is hereby made the duty of the Village Treasurer to render bills for service and all other charges in connection wherewith and to collect all monies due therefrom.

Section 4. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed in so far as the conflicting portions hereof are concerned.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall be published in full in The Argus, a newspaper of general circulation in the Village, promptly after its adoption, and shall be recorded in the Ordinance Book of the Village and such recording authenticated by the signatures of the Village President and Village Clerk.

Section 6. This Ordinance is hereby determined by the Village Council to be immediately necessary for the preservation of the peach, health and safety of the Village and is therefore declared to have immediate effect.
