

VILLAGE OF AUGUSTA, MICHIGAN

ORDINANCE NO. 123

ADOPTED: July 14, 1975

EFFECTIVE: August 5, 1975

An Ordinance to amend Ordinance No. 113 of the Village of Augusta, Kalamazoo County, Michigan, pertaining to the outdoor storage of vehicles and new or used parts therefrom, so as to allow up to four inoperable motor vehicles to be stored at any service station, garage or similar automobile repair facility at any one time; and to repeal any ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith.

ORDAINS:

SECTION I

Section 3 entitled Regulations of Ordinance No. 113 of the Village of Augusta, pertaining to the parking and storage of vehicles and parts thereof, subsection (a) (5) is hereby deleted and in its place and stead the following is hereby enacted:

5. Up to four (4) inoperable vehicles may be stored at any service station, body shop, paint shop or garage at any one time.

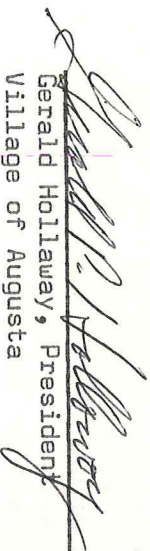
SECTION II

Said Ordinance of the Village of Augusta no 113 shall remain in full force and effect, except as hereby amended. The penalty provisions contained in Section 6 of said Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect, as if set forth herein in entirety.
