ORDINANCE NO. 127

ADOPTED: NOVEMBER 8, 1976

EFFECTIVE: NOVEMBER 23, 1976

An ordinance to amend Ordinance No. 126 of the Village of Augusta, Kalamazoo County, Michigan defining and prohibiting nuisances in the Village of Augusta, providing for the abatement thereof, and prescribing penalties for the violation of its provisions.

ORDAINS:

SECTION I

Section II, Part 2, - D shall be deleted from the Village of Augusta Nuisance Ordinance No. 126 having to do with acreage restrictions for animals with the Village limits.

SECTION II

Said Ordinance of the Village of Augusta No. 126 shall remain in full force and effect, except as hereby amended. The penalty provisions as contained in Section VII of said Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect, as if set forth herein in entirety.

SECTION III

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed. This Ordinance shall take effect on November 23, 1976.
