ORDINANCE:

SECTION I.

Ordinance No. 115, enacted the 24th day of June, 1974, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows: All regular and special meetings of the Village Council shall be held on the second, third, and fourth Monday evenings of each month at such time and place as the Council may determine.

SECTION II.

The second paragraph of Ordinance No. 115 enacted the 24th day of June, 1974, be the same is hereby amended to read as follows: All regular meetings of the Village Council shall open and the rollcall shall be made at 7:30 P.M. at local time all times of any year.

SECTION III.

Any Ordinance, or part of an Ordinance, in conflict herewith is hereby repealed.

SECTION IV.

Severability: The provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable and if any clause, sentence, paragraph, section or subsection is declared void or inoperable for any reason, it shall not affect any other part of portion thereof.
