

AUGUSTA VILLAGE ORDINANCE NO. 143

AUGUSTA VILLAGE UNIFORM TRAFFIC CODE

Adopted: August 13, 1979

Effective: September 13, 1979

An Ordinance to adopt, by reference, the Uniform Traffic Code for Michigan cities, townships and villages as promulgated by the Department of State Police.

ORDAINS:

SECTION I. CODE ADOPTED.

The Uniform Traffic Code for cities, townships and villages promulgated as emergency rules by the Department of State Police and filed with the Secretary of State for the State of Michigan on July 27, 1979, and which is to be published in Supplement No. 100 of the Michigan Administrative Code in accordance with 1956 PA 62, as amended, is hereby adopted in full by reference thereto except as in this Ordinance modified.

SECTION II. REFERENCES IN CODE.

References in the Uniform Traffic Code for Michigan cities, townships and villages to "governmental unit" shall mean the Village of Augusta.

SECTION III. NOTICE TO BE PUBLISHED.

The Village Clerk shall publish this Ordinance in the manner required by law and shall at the same time publish

a supplementary notice setting forth the purpose of said Uniform Traffic Code and of the fact that complete copies of the Code are available at the Office of the Clerk for inspection by and distribution to the public at all times.

SECTION IV. REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCES.

All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith, including any previous Ordinance adopted by this Village for the purpose of adopting prior additions of the said Uniform Traffic Code are hereby repealed as of 12:00 midnight on the 12th day of September 1979.

SECTION V. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This Ordinance shall take effect at 12:01 A. M. on the 13th day of September, 1979.
