

## FIREARMS ORDINANCE

ORDINANCE NO. 145

ADOPTED: 2-11-80

EFFECTIVE: 3-11-80

An Ordinance of the Village of Augusta to regulate or prohibit the discharge of firearms, to provide penalties for the violation thereof, and to repeal any parts or portions of ordinances of the Village which are inconsistent herewith.

The Village of Augusta, Kalamazoo County, Michigan, ordains:

## SECTION I

It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to shoot or discharge any pistol, revolver, shotgun, rifle, pellet gun or other firearm or weapon within the Village limits.

## SECTION II

The Village Board of Trustees may upon application in writing, grant a permit to hunt predatory animals within the Village limits. No permit shall be for more than seven (7) days' duration. In granting a permit, there shall be a minimum distance of 200 ft. from any residence or person and only between the hours of 9:00 A. M. and 2:00 P. M.

## SECTION III

Upon conviction of any person violating the provisions of this Ordinance shall be punished by a fine not exceeding Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), together with the costs of prosecution, or by imprisonment in the County Jail for not more than ninety (90) days, or by both such fine and imprisonment, in the discretion of the court.
