ORDINANCE NO. 148

AMENDMENT TO VILLAGE PARKING ORDINANCE

Adopted: December 22, 1980

Effective: January 20, 1981

An Ordinance to amend Section 3 of Ordinance 62 and Section 2 of Ordinance 104 as it pertains to the over-night parking upon the streets within the Village of Augusta and to repeal all parts or portions of ordinances which are in conflict herewith.

ORDAINS:

SECTION I

Article III of Ordinance 62 adopted on September 8, 1952, and effective September 28, 1952, is hereby repealed.

SECTION II

Section 2 of Ordinance 104 which was adopted November 24, 1969, effective November 24, 1969, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Motor vehicles shall not be parked between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. on public streets within the Village, except in designated areas where overnight parking is specifically permitted and which is appropriately marked with a sign or signs and then only subject to any regulations pertaining to such parking. For these purposes, the term 'public street' is that portion of the road which is paved to the curb and if no curb exists, it includes six feet of the shoulder on each side; and for gravel roads, it means that portion of the roadway which is improved and intended for vehicular travel."
