

ORDINANCE NO. 158

An Ordinance to designate an enforcing agency to discharge the responsibilities of the Village of Augusta under the provisions of the State Construction Code Act (Act 230 of the Public Acts of 1972, as amended).

The Village of Augusta ordains:

Sec. 1 Agency Designated. Pursuant to the provisions of the Michigan Plumbing Code, in accordance with Act 230 of Public Acts of 1972, as amended, the plumbing inspector official of the State of Michigan is hereby designated as the enforcing agency to discharge the responsibilities of the Village of Augusta under Act 230 of the Public Acts of 1972, as amended, State of Michigan. The State of Michigan hereby is granted the responsibility for the administration and enforcement of said Act throughout its corporate limits.

Sec. 2. All ordinance inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

Sec. 3. This Ordinance shall be effective after legal publication and in accordance with the provisions of the Act governing same.

This Ordinance duly adopted on June 25, 1984 at a regular meeting of the Board of Trustees, Village of Augusta and will become effective July 25, 1984.
