CEMETERY BURIAL VAULT ORDINANCE

An ordinance to require concrete burial vaults for all interments hereafter within the village cemetery and to repeal any parts or portions of ordinances which are in conflict with this ordinance.

KALAMAZOO COUNTY, MICHIGAN,

ORDAINS:

 $\underline{\underline{\text{SECTION 1}}}_{\text{Commencing with the effective date of this ordinance, all interments}}$ within the village cemetery hereafter shall use a concrete burial vault. No interments of caskets, or oter burial containers shall be allowed unless placed within a concrete burial vault. Cremains may be interred without a vault.

SECTION II

The Village Cemetery Board of Trustees and/or the Village Council shall be authorized to provide rules or regulations pertaining to burials and the use of burial vaults, including specifications for burial vaults.

SECTION III

Any ordinance or part of an ordinance of the Village of Augusta which is in conflict with this ordinance shall be null and void and shall be deemed to be repealed by this ordinance.

SECTION IV

The provisions of this ordinance is severable, should any section, paragraph, sentence or word be held to be invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, and the remaining terms of this ordinance shall not be affected thereby.

SECTION V

This ordinance shall be effective Dec. 1, 1986.
