

VILLAGE OF AUGUSTA ORDINANCE NO. 165

PARKING ORDINANCE

VILLAGE OF AUGUSTA, MICHIGAN

An ordinance pertaining to parking regulations on South Webster St. at Clinton St. limiting the parking in certain spaces to one hour. And to amend or revoke any other ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith:

The Village of Augusta ordains:

Three parking stalls on South Webster at Clinton St, are established as one hour parking areas. Motor vehicles shall not be parked in such parking spaces for more than one hour.

Any ordinance or part of an ordinance in conflict herewith is hereby repealed.

The provisions of this ordinance are hereby declared to be severable. If any clause, sentence, paragraph, section or subsection is declared void or unoperable for any reason, it shall not affect any other part or portion thereof.

This ordinance is declared to be an emergency enactment and shall take immediate effect. Date August 11, 1986.
