 PARKING REGULATION ORDINANCE

An ordinance repealing certain parking regulations on South Webster Street from Michigan Avenue to Clinton Street and further to Fayette Street. This ordinance amends Ordinance Nos. 108, 160, and 165 and repeals those parts of the Ordinances in conflict herewith:

## ORDAINS:

SECTION I

All one hour and two hour parking limitation regulations designated at various parking stalls located along either side of Webster Street from Michigan Avenue to Clinton Street and further to Fayette Street are hereby repealed.

SECTION II

Any ordinance or part of an ordinance in conflict herewith is hereby repealed.

SECTION III

The provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable. If any clause, sentence, paragraph, section or subsection is declared void or unoperable for any reason it shall not affect any other part or portion thereof.

SECTION IV

This ordinance shall be effective upon publication.
