

VILLAGE OF AUGUSTA

ORDINANCE NO. 82

ADOPTED: December 13th, 1965

EFFECTIVE: January 4th, 1966.

An Ordinance regulating the parking of motor and other vehicles on public streets within the Village of Augusta, to prescribe penalties for the violation of its provision, and to repeal all Ordinances in conflict herewith.

THE VILLAGE OF AUGUSTA, KALAMAZOO COUNTY, MICHIGAN, ORDAINS:

Section 1. Title. This Ordinance shall be known as the Parking Ordinance of the Village of Augusta and may be referred to or cited by that title.

Section 2. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to park or leave standing unattended any motor or other vehicle, whether designed for public or private conveyance, in or upon any public street within the Village of Augusta, between the hours of 2 A.M. and 6 A.M.

Section 3. Appropriate signs designating the parking restrictions prescribed by this Ordinance shall be erected on all streets of access to the Village of Augusta, and when erected shall be deemed notice to all persons, firms or corporations of said parking restrictions.

Section 4. Penalties for violation. Any person, firm or corporation who violates the provisions of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction, be punished by a fine of not more than One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars for each offense, or by imprisonment in the county jail for a period not to exceed ninety (90) days, or by both such fine and imprisonment. Each day that a violation is permitted to exist shall constitute a separate offense.

Section 5. Severability. The provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable, and if any clause, sentence, paragraph, section or subsection is declared void or inoperable for any reason, it shall not affect any part or portion thereof.

Section 6. Repeal Clause. All Ordinances adopted by the Village of Augusta deemed in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

7. This Ordinance shall become effective on the 4th day of January, 1966.
