ORDINANCE NO. 86

Adopted: July 10, 1967

Effective: July 30, 1967

An Ordinance to amend Ordinance No. 1 to provide for regular meetings of the Council twice each month; to amend Ordinance No. 39 to provide for the opening and roll call of each meeting at 7:30 P.M.; to amend Ordinance No. 78 to provide for additional salaries for Village Clerk, Treasurer and Assessor; and to amend or revoke any other Ordinance, or parts of Ordinances, in conflict herewith.

THE VILLAGE OF AUGUSTA, KALAMAZOO COUNTY, MICHIGAN,

ORDAINS:

Section 1. Ordinance No. 1, enacted the 16th day of September, 1895, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows: All regular and special meetings of the Village Council shall be held on the second and fourth Monday evenings of each month at such time and place as the Council may determine.

Section 2. The second paragraph of Ordinance No. 39, enacted the 10th day of June, 1918, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows: All regular meetings of the Village Council shall open and the roll call shall be made at 7:30 P.M. at local time all times of any year.

Section 3. Section 1 of Ordinance No. 78, enacted the 10th day of February, 1964, entitled, "An Ordinance to Establish the Salaries for the Clerk, Assessor and Treasurer", be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows: The annual salaries for the following officers of the Village of Augusta shall be:

A. Village Clerk	\$ 1,250.00
B. Village Assessor	400.00
C. Village Treasurer	750.00

The salaries shall be paid annually.

Section 4. Any Ordinance, or part of an Ordinance, in conflict herewith is hereby repealed.

Section 5. Severability. The provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable and if any clause, sentence, paragraph, section or sub-section is declared void or inoperable for any reason, it shall not affect any other part or portion thereof.

Section 6. This Ordinance shall take effect on July 30, 1967.
