An Ordinance to amend Ordinance No. 8 relative to licensing shows, exhibits and auctions and to amend or revoke any other Ordinances, or parts of Ordinances, in conflict herewith:


ORDAINS:


Section 1. Ordinance No. 8, enacted on the 16th day of September, 1895, entitled, "An Ordinance Relative to Shows, Exhibitions and Auctions", be and the same is hereby amended by adding thereto and inserting therein, following Section 1, thereof, the following to be known as Section 1(a): Before any license may be granted, if, in the opinion of the Village Council, police protection will be necessary as a result of any show, exhibition or auction and resulting in additional costs to the Village, the Council may require the payment of an additional sum for said license based on the cost of providing the police protection. Furthermore, before a license for any show, exhibition or auction may be granted, if public property (real or personal) is to be used in or for said show, exhibition or auction, a \$20 deposit shall be paid to the Village Treasurer, to be held until satisfactory return and/or restoration of the property. In addition, if any show, exhibition or auction is held on any Village property, the Village and the members of the Village Council are to be indemnified from any loss or claim by a bond or insurance policy naming the Village and the Village Council as the insured with a minimum liability coverage of \$20,000 per incident; a copy of said insurance policy or bond is to be received by the Village Treasurer before issuance of the license.

Section 2. Any Ordinance or part of an Ordinance in conflict herewith is hereby repealed.

Section 3. Severability. The provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable, and if any clause, sentence, paragraph, section or sub-section is declared void, or inoperable for any reason, it shall not affect any part or portion thereof.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall be effective on July 30, 1967.


