ORDINANCE NO. 91

Adopted: July 24, 1967

Effective: July 24, 1967

An Ordinance to prohibit the parking of motor vehicles on the south side of Clinton Street from a point 20 feet west of the Fire Department Drive to Webster Street; to limit the parking to a maximum parking time of two hours on the north side of Clinton Street between Chestnut and Webster Streets; and to amend or revoke any other ordinance, or parts of ordinances, in conflict herewith:

THE VILLAGE OF AUGUSTA, KALAMAZOO COUNTY, MICHIGAN,
ORDAINS:

Section 1. The parking of motor vehicles on the south side of Clinton Street between a point 20 feet west of the Fire Department drive and Webster Street shall be prohibited at all times.

Section 2. Motor vehicles shall not be parked on the north side of Clinton Street between Chestnut and Webster Streets for a longer period of time than two hours.

Section 3. Any ordinance, or part of an ordinance, in conflict herewith is hereby repealed.

Section 4. Severability. The provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable. If any clause, sentence, paragraph, section or sub-section is declared void or inoperable for any reason, it shall not affect any other part or portion thereof.

Section 5. This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency enactment and shall take immediate effect.
