ORDINANCE NO. 93

Adopted: August 14, 1967

Effective: September 3, 1967

An Ordinance to repeal Ordinance Nos. 19, 22, 23, and 33 pertaining to construction, maintenance, and operation of interurban street railway lines.

THE VILLAGE OF AUGUSTA, KALAMAZOO COUNTY, MICHIGAN,

ORDAINS:

Section 1. Ordinances 19, 22, 23, and 33 enacted the 11th day of January, 1897, the 22nd day of June, 1898, the 17th day of July, 1899, and the 12th day of October, 1908, respectively, pertaining to construction, maintenance, and operation of interurban street railway lines, be and the same are hereby repealed.

Section 2. Any Ordinance or part of an Ordinance in conflict herewith is hereby repealed.

Section 3. Severability. The provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable. If any clause, sentence, paragraph, section or subsection is declared void or inoperable for any reason, it shall not affect any other part or portion thereof.
