An Ordinance to repeal Ordinance Nos. 20, 35, and 51 relative to the sale of spirituous malts and intoxicating liquors in the Village.

THE VILLAGE OF AUGUSTA, KALAMAZOO COUNTY, MICHIGAN,

ORDAINS:

Section 1. Ordinances 20, 35 and 51 enacted on the 12th day of April, 1897, the 14th day of March, 1910, and the 12th day of October, 1942, respectively, pertaining to the sale of spirituous malt and intoxicating liquors, be and the same are hereby repealed.

Section 2. Any Ordinance or part of an Ordinance in conflict herewith is hereby repealed.

Section 3. Severability. The provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable. If any clause, sentence, paragraph, section or subsection is declared void or inoperable for any reason, it shall not affect any other part or portion thereof.
