

VILLAGE OF AUGUSTA ORDINANCE #97

Adopted: September 23, 1968

Effective: October 24, 1968

An Ordinance to prohibit the tampering with fire hydrants; to prohibit the opening of fire hydrant valves, except under certain circumstances, and to provide for violations.

THE VILLAGE OF AUGUSTA, KALAMAZOO COUNTY, MICHIGAN,

ORDAINS:

Section 1. No person, persons, firm or corporation shall open or turn-on any fire hydrant valve, or otherwise tamper with any fire hydrant located within the Village limits, unless they obtain specific authority to do so from the Village Board, Village Fire Chief or the Acting Village Fire Chief, or unless necessary to fight a fire.

Section 2. Any person, persons, firm or corporation violating any provision of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction, be fined not more than \$100.00, nor more than 90 days' imprisonment, or both such fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the Court.

Section 3. Any Ordinance or part of an Ordinance in conflict herewith is herewith repealed.

Section 4. Severability. The provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable. If any clause, sentence, paragraph, section or sections is declared void or inoperable for any reason, it shall not effect any other part or portion thereof.
