

VILLAGE OF AUGUSTA ORDINANCE NO. 98

ADOPTED: December 23, 1968

EFFECTIVE: Immediately - December 23, 1968

An ordinance to protect the public health, safety and general welfare by regulating the operation of snow-mobiles within the Village; to provide penalties for the violation of this Ordinance and to amend or revoke any other ordinances, or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith;

THE VILLAGE OF AUGUSTA, KALAMAZOO COUNTY,

MICHIGAN, ORDAINS:

Section 1. Definition. A snow-mobile means any motorized vehicle designed primarily for travel on snow or ice and steered by wheels, skies, or runners.

Section 2. All snow-mobiles must be maintained and operated in accordance with Public Act 74, 1968 (C.L.'48, S257.1501 through 257.1518).

** Section 4. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm, or corporation to operate a snow-mobile on any public property within the Village, including any streets, alleys, street rights of way, sidewalks, parks, playgrounds, school properties, cemeteries, or any other public properties, except in emergencies as permitted in Section 3 above. Notwithstanding the above, a snow-mobile may be operated across a street, alley, or sidewalk, when necessary to reach private property on which the snow-mobile is to be operated, as long as it does not interfere with any motor vehicle or pedestrian traffic.

** Section 3. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to operate any snow-mobile within the Village between the hours of 10:00 P.M. and 8:00 A.M. unless necessary in an emergency when normal vehicles can not operate due to weather conditions.

Section 5. No person, firm or corporation shall operate a snow-mobile in any area which is being used by minors for purposes other than riding, operating or being towed by snow-mobiles.

Section 6. Penalties Any person, firm or corporation violating any provision of this ordinance shall upon conviction be fined not more than \$100 or not more than 90 days imprisonment, or shall have both such fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the Court.

Section 7. Any ordinance or part of an ordinance in conflict herewith is hereby repealed.

Section 8. Severability. The provisions of this ordinance are hereby declared to be severable. If any clause, sentence, paragraph, section, or subsection is declared void or inoperable for any reason, it shall not affect any other part or portion thereof.

Section 9. This ordinance is declared to be an emergency enactment and shall take immediate effect.
