

RESOLUTION VACATING A PORTION OF CHERRY STREET

**VILLAGE OF AUGUSTA, MICHIGAN
RESOLUTION NO. 03063001**

The following resolution was offered by Council Member Beatty and supported by Council Member Radgett:

WHEREAS, the Village Council adopted a resolution of intent to vacate a portion of Cherry Street on Monday, June 2, 2003, and set a date of Monday, June 30, 2003 to meet and hear objections regarding the proposed vacation of a portion of Cherry Street, and

WHEREAS, notice of this meeting, with a copy of the resolution of intent attached, was given in the manner prescribed by the Open Meetings Act, being 1976 PA 267, and

WHEREAS, the Village Council has met on this date to receive and hear any objections to the proposed vacation of a portion of Cherry Street, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Village Council hereby determines that it is necessary for the health, welfare, comfort, and safety of the Village to vacate that portion of Cherry Street described below.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Village Council, pursuant to the authority granted to it in MCLA 67.13 and MCLA 560.257, hereby vacates that portion of Cherry Street described as:

That portion of Cherry Street lying between the northerly right-of-way line of Jackson Street and the southerly right-of-way line of Washington Street and abutting Lots 4, 8, 9, and 13, Block 16, Range 3, plat of the Village of Augusta, Kalamazoo County, Michigan.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Village Clerk shall within thirty (30) days record a certified copy of this Resolution with the Kalamazoo County Register of Deeds and file a certified copy with the State Treasurer and the State Department of Consumer and Industry Services.


