TOWN OF FORESTVILLE, DOOR COUNTY Ordinance # 2017-03 To Designate Class "B" Highways

STATE OF WISCONSIN Town of Forestville Door County

The Town Board of the Town of Forestville, Door County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority under s. 349.15 (2), Wis. stats., to adopt this ordinance.

This Ordinance, adopted by a majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, designates town highways as class "B" highways in the town as follows:

- A. The following town highways in the Town of Forestville are designated class "B" highways subject to the weight limits set forth in s. 348.16 (2), Wis. stats., unless increased by town ordinance:
 - 1. Old Elm Road (East of State Highway 42 and West of County Road "O")
 - 2. Rosewood Road (East of So. Carnot Road and West of County Highway "S")
 - 3. Gaede Road
 - 4. Old Krueger Road (North of County Line Road and South of County "J")
- B. The town chairperson or his or her designee, shall place appropriate traffic signs on the above-described highways on or before the effective date of this ordinance.
- C. No person may operate any vehicle on the above noted highways in violation of the weights limits set forth in s. 348.16 (2), Wis. stats. Upon conviction for a violation of this ordinance, the violator shall pay a forfeiture of \$500 plus the applicable surcharges, assessments, and costs for each violation. Each trip in violation of this ordinance constitutes a separate offense. In addition, the town board may seek injunctive relief from a court of record to enjoin further violations.

This ordinance is effective on May 1st, 2017.
