TOWN OF FORESTVILLE, DOOR COUNTY Ordinance # 2017-08 To Establish Split Shifts for Election Officials

STATE OF WISCONSIN Town of Forestville Door County

The Town Board of the Town of Forestville, Door County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority under s. 7.30(1), Wis. stats., to adopt this ordinance.

This Ordinance, adopted by a majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, provides for the of 2 (or more) sets of officials to work at different times on each election day as follows:

- A. There may be 2 shifts for election workers on all election days. The first shift shall commence at 6:30 a.m. and end at 1:30 p.m. The second shift shall commence at 1:30 p.m. and end with completion of all required election day duties that follow the closure of the polls.
- B. The Town Board may, for each election appoint one additional election inspector to serve between the hours of 6:30 a.m. and 1:30 p.m. and one additional election inspector to serve between the hours of 1:30 p.m. and 8:30 p.m. (poll closing time) at the polling place in this Town. Each additional election inspector shall serve as a greeter to answer questions and to direct electors to the proper locations for registration and voting and shall be available to substitute for other election officials who must leave the room during the voting process

This ordinance is effective on publication or posting.
