

CHAPTER XIII.

SNOWMOBILE OPERATION

SECTION 13.00. Purpose. The purpose of this chapter is to designate routes within the Town of Spring Prairie where snowmobile operation is lawful under the authority of Section 350.047, Wis. Stats.

SECTION 13.10. Official Map. The routes designated as lawful routes are those provided and shown on the official snowmobile map approved by the Town Board by formal resolution and on file at the office of the Town Clerk. Operation of snowmobiles on any area or road other than the prescribed routes is declared unlawful.

SECTION 13.20. Hours of Operation. All snowmobile operation on the prescribed routes shall be prohibited between the hours of 12:00 midnight and 6:00 a.m. of each day.

SECTION 13.30. Rules of Operation. The rules for snowmobile operation shall be as follows:

- A. The maximum speed for snowmobile operation shall be 10 miles per hour.
- B. All snowmobile operation shall be on the extreme right side of the roadway and all left turns shall be made as safely as possible from any position depending on snow cover and other prevailing conditions.
- C. Snowmobile operators shall yield the right-of-way to other vehicular traffic and pedestrians.
- E. No snowmobile operation is permitted on State Trunk Highways or connecting streets except as provided under Section 350.02 Wis. Stats.

SECTION 13.40. Route Marking. The Town Board hereby designates the Lyons Sno-Bums Snowmobile Club to mark the prescribed routes in accordance with Section 350.13 Wis. Stats.; provided that such

designation may be revoked, amended or modified by resolution of the Town Board from time to time.

SECTION 13.50. Penalty. Any person, firm, or corporation violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction, forfeit not less than \$50 nor more than \$100 for each offense, together with the costs of prosecution, and in default of payment of such forfeiture and costs, shall be imprisoned in the County Jail of Walworth County until the same are paid, not to exceed 30 days.
