CHAPTER XIV.

SPEED ZONES

SECTION 14.00. <u>Purpose</u>. The purpose of this chapter is to modify existing speed limits on designated Town roads within the Town of Spring Prairie pursuant to Section 349.11(3)(c) Wis. Stats. and to confirm speed zones previously created by ordinance.

SECTION 14.10. <u>Prohibited Speeds and Zones</u>. No person shall drive a vehicle at a speed in excess of the following limits in the zones herein set forth:

- A. 45 miles per hour on Spring Prairie Road between its intersection with S.T.H. 11 and its intersection with County Trunk Highway DD.
- B. 30 miles per hour on Potter Road from its intersection with Country Trunk Highway DD, westerly for a distance of 0.30 of a mile.
- C. 45 miles per hour on Potter Road from of its intersection with Lyons Road easterly to a point 0.30 of a mile west of its intersection with C.T.H. DD.
- D. 45 miles per hour on Lyons Road from its intersection with S.T.H. 11, southerly to the Spring Prairie/Lyons Town boundary line.
- E. 45 miles per hour on Lyons Road between its intersection with Spring Prairie Road and its intersection with Potter Road.
- F. 45 miles per hour on Aspen Drive, Vail Drive and Chateau Court.
- G. 35 miles per hour on Paradise Drive; East Paradise Road; Dixon Drive; Horse Hollow Lane, a/k/a Horsehollow Lane; Ski Hill Drive and Clayton Court.
- H. 45 miles per hour on Hargraves Road between its intersection with Spring Prairie Road and its intersection with County Trunk Highway D.
- I. 45 miles per hour for the entire length of Valley View Road.

SECTION 14.20. <u>Penalty</u>. Any person violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance may be required to forfeit not less than \$40 nor more than \$300 for each offense, together with costs of prosecution.
