



#### FY 2025-2026 Budget

- The Board of Aldermen and City Staff are meeting and developing our budget for next year. *Andy Adams, City Administrator*, has developed a great guide that explains our budget. Please take time to review this guide at the City's Financial Transparency Webpage (click here)
- We are also developing a water system bond proposal. This bond is critical to maintaining the water system. The link to the guide above includes information about the bond proposal. The bond proposal will not require any increases to the water rates.

- The Board of Aldermen has had several budget work sessions and continues discussions regarding the budget during each regular BOA meeting. These meetings are open to the public and you are encouraged to attend.
- Andy and I will make arrangements to meet with any group or individuals that would like more information.

#### **City Meetings**

- **Board of Aldermen:** The BOA is continuing work on the budget for next year at each Board meeting. There is a special Budget Workshop scheduled for July 1, 5:30pm and a regular BOA meeting scheduled for 7pm the same day. (Community Center)
- **Planning & Zoning:** The P&Z is working on a new Comprehensive Plan. Our current Comprehensive Plan was developed in 2004 and received some minor updates in 2014. Next Meeting: July 10, at 6:00 PM. (Community Center)

#### **Legislative Updates**

- The Texas Legislature closed out its regular session last month. Andy is writing a guide to assist with reviewing the new laws to determine which of our ordinances have been affected. New laws require us to update our ordinances accordingly. Updating ordinances will require the combined efforts of the Planning and Zoning Commission, the Board of Aldermen, City Staff, City Attorney and E-code staff.
- You may know that the Governor has called for a Special Session which will begin on July 21<sup>st</sup>. We can expect new laws which may require additional ordinance changes.
- Andy and I attended a Legislative Wrap Up Conference on June 27, where Texas Municipal League provided a comprehensive overview of the new laws.

#### **Drought Update**

- We are receiving complaints that many property owners are not following the currently approved lawn irrigation schedule.
- The City of Highland Haven has initiated restrictions for lawn watering to once a week, consistent with LCRA restrictions.
- Please reset your sprinkler system to <u>once a week</u> using the schedule below.
  - Odd addresses water lawns on Saturday
    - Hours: Midnight to 10 a.m. and 7 p.m. to midnight.
  - Even addresses water lawns on Sunday
    - Hours: Midnight to 10 a.m. and 7 p.m. to midnight.
- The City of Highland Haven is required to have a drought continency plan and we are currently at Stage 4; please review our webpage for more details about our restrictions.


- Please advise your family and your visitors.
