FY 2025-2026 Budget

• The Board of Aldermen adopted the FY25-26 budget on August 13 after hearing public input on August 5 and August 12. Many thanks to The Board of Aldermen and City Staff for their diligent work developing this budget. Andy Adams, City Administrator, has developed a great guide that explains our budget. Water Bond

- The Board of Alderman also passed an ordinance to order a bond election, scheduled for November 4, 2025. This proposed general obligation bond is for the purchase of 8.36 acres of property that includes 2 of the city's water wells and to address critical water system repairs and upgrades.
- The proposed bond will not require any increases to property tax rates or water rates.

City Meetings

- **Board of Aldermen:** The BOA is continuing work on the budget for next year at each Board meeting. Next BOA meeting is September 2nd, 7pm, Highland Haven Community Center.
- **Planning & Zoning:** The P&Z is continuing work on a new Comprehensive Plan and is planning several Townhall Meetings to gather more information from citizens. The first Townhall Meeting is scheduled for September 25th at 6:00 PM at the Community Center.
- Our current Comprehensive Plan was developed in 2004 and received some minor updates in 2014.

Legislative Updates

• Water customers should have received their annual Customer Confidence Report. Our drinking water is safe and meets Texas Commission on Environmental Quality water quality requirements Should have any questions, please contact City Hall.

Drought Update

- The City of Highland Haven is required to have a drought continency plan and we are now at Stage 2; please review our webpage for more details.
 - o Highland Haven Drought-Contingency Plan
- Our water system is permitted by the Central Texas Groundwater District and the District issued Stage 2 drought status effective July 28 at their monthly board meeting.
- CTGCD meets monthly and the Board of Directors consider aquafer levels and determine the drought status for groundwater use in Burnet County.
- Property owners and residents are encouraged to schedule your sprinkler system to once a week using the recommended days below.
 - Odd addresses water lawns on Saturday
 - Hours: Midnight to 10 a.m. and 8 p.m. to midnight.
 - o Even addresses water lawns on Sunday
 - Hours: Midnight to 10 a.m. and 8 p.m. to midnight.

Mowing

- The recent rains have caused grass to grow, and many lots and homes are in need to be mowing. We are receiving complaints about overgrown yards causing mosquito and mice issues. Please check your property and help us keep Highland Haven beautiful and safe.


