#### **City Hall Office Holiday Hours**

## **Board of Alderman**

- Next BOA meeting is 7pm, December 6. This will be the last scheduled meeting for the year.
- BOA meetings will resume on January 10 at 7pm.
- BOA meetings are open to the public. Residents and property owners are encouraged to attend.
- BOA meetings are held in the Community Center.

#### **Planning and Zoning Commission**

- Next meeting is 6pm, December 8. This will be the last scheduled meeting for the year.
- P&Z meetings will resume January 12 at 6pm.
- Residents and property owners are encouraged to attend.
- P&Z meetings are held in the Community Center.

#### **Water System**

- We are still in Stage 4 CRITICAL drought conditions. Central Texas Groundwater Conservation District moved into Stage 4 CRITICAL drought conditions effective June 13<sup>th</sup>. Stage 4 is the highest out of a total of four stages. Stage 4 calls for voluntary conservation of groundwater by 30 percent. Our water system is permitted by the Central Texas Groundwater Conservation District.
- Property owners irrigating with private wells and lake water should also be following the Central Texas Groundwater Conservation District and LCRA restrictions.

- o Reduce outdoor water usage and follow the LCRA lawn watering schedule below.
  - Wednesdays and Saturdays for addresses ending in odd numbers.
  - Thursdays and Sundays for addresses ending in even numbers.
  - Hours: Midnight to 10 a.m. and 7 p.m. to Midnight.

#### **Trees and Shrubs**

- This is the time of the year to plant new trees. Please take time to plan to avoid future problems when the tree is fully grown. Below are some resources to consider before planting.

- Please check and make sure your tree limbs are trimmed back to provide a minimum clearance of 15' above streets to accommodate emergency vehicles, trash trucks and RV's.

#### Fire Safety

- The County wide Burn Ban has been lifted. Please take this opportunity to dispose of all brush and lawn trimmings stacked on your property.
