## **Lowering Lake LBJ**

- LCRA announced Lakes LBJ and Austin would be lowered for about six weeks beginning Jan. 2, 2017. The lake lowerings will conclude about Feb. 13, 2017. Visit lcra.org/lakelowerings for more information.
- Please contact James Warren, Highland Haven Building Permit Officer, and apply for a building permit before starting any dock or seawall maintenance projects. Do not put off applying for a permit. Waterfront building permits can require significant lead-time for review and approval.

#### Lot Maintenance

- Property owners are responsible for maintaining right of way areas abutting their property.

- Check the drainage areas around your home and make sure that the culverts are open and drainage ditches (swales) between houses are maintained so storm water is carried away.
